## ABOUT THE COURSE

The purpose of the English for an Academic Purpose (EAP) Program is to meet the academic skills required for the learners to gain an entry into vocational programs (VET) at Auscanus Institute of Australia or other education providers, TAFE and Universities in Australia or in tertiary education qualification.

### Course Entry Requirements:

**Age:** Are at least at age of 18 on the date of course commencement.

**Education Level:** Australian Year 12 or equivalent.

**English Language:** Minimum IELTS score of 6.0 or PTE Academic score of 50 or equivalent or have completed the ELICOS General English (Intermediate Level).

# DELIVERY MODE AND ASSESSMENT

### Who can Enrol?

This course is designed for candidates over 18 years old who hold a valid Australian Visa (onshore and offshore). It is designed for a formal classroom setting; the methodology and content are directed to adults from different backgrounds who are willing to improve their English as a second language knowledge and proficiency for General or Academic purposes. This includes the notion that language learning is a conscious process, and that learning and acquisition of language can arise from interaction both with others and with materials.

### Further Pathways?

Completing the all 3 levels of ELICOS for Academic Purposes program opens up various pathways for international students to pursue further studies, career opportunities or personal growth. Some of the common pathways includes studies in VET sector or Higher Education Sector including Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

### Assessment Methodology

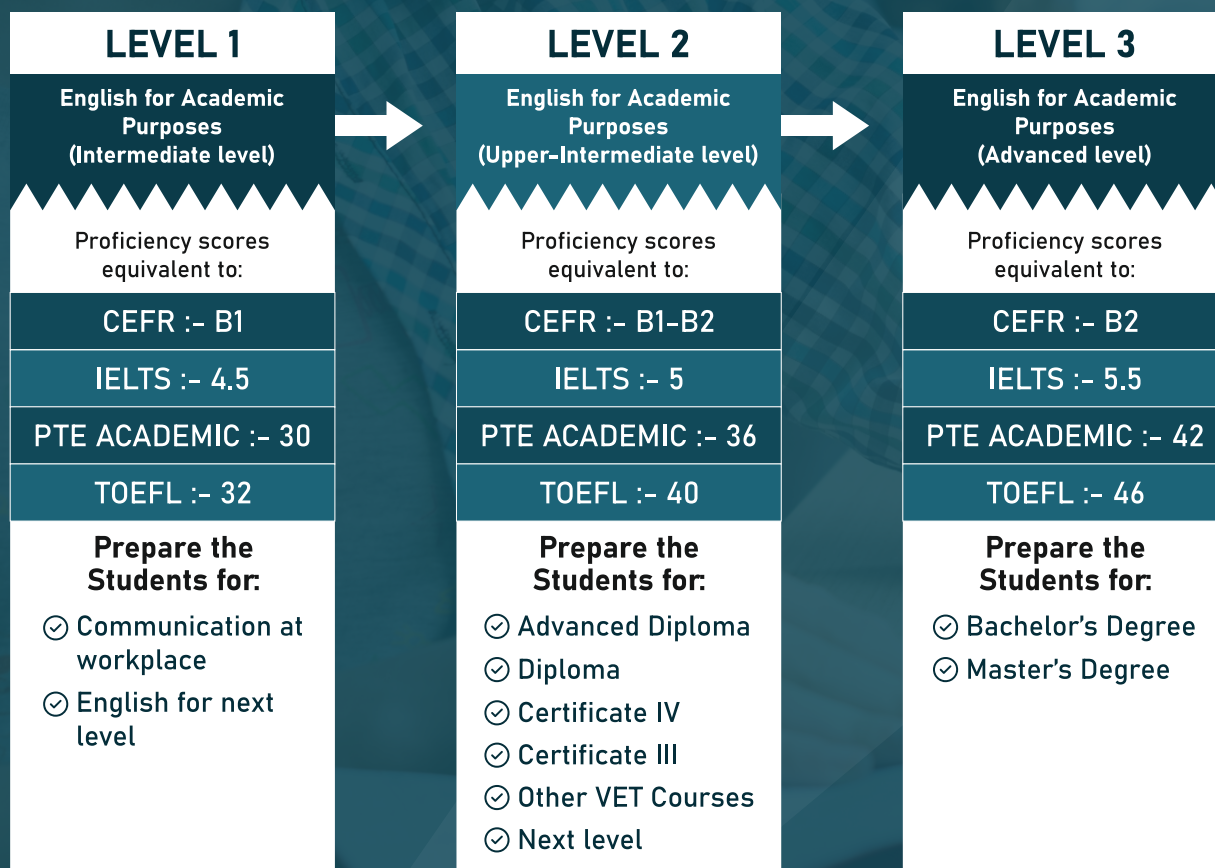
Assessment methods used for this course are varied and some of the methodology includes, ongoing class-based assessment, proficiency level testing to show course progress, audio/video material, research and more.

There are total of 3 level in EAP. The first level is Intermediate, the second level is Upper-Intermediate and the third level is Advanced. Each proficient level is consisting of 10 weeks of learning and then student moves to the next level.
